Now click on the Adapters tab at the top of the window. Once in this section, make sure there is nothing in the large white box with the label Network Adapters. Following this, click on the Protocols tab at the top of the screen to reveal a large white box with the label Network Protocols. Make sure the TCP/IP protocol is installed, and if not, click on Add... (don't be concerned if there are other protocols install other than TCP/IP, if any at all)

Once NT restarted and you have logged on, double click *My Computer* and then *Dial-Up Networking*. Your will now enter a *New Phonebook Entry Wizard*. Enter **NewWave Internet** in the *name the new phonebook entry* field, and then click on Next.
